He required a lot of caregiving from the day he came to live in Charunibas on 17.02.2022.

The last rites were performed by his younger brother in our presence on 10.05.2025. Like Khudiram, his farewell was with tears and prayers by all in Charunibas.

Ranu came on 10th April 2025 and was referred by Hive India, while Kalyani was rescued and referred from Thakurpukur Police Station. She came home on 13th April 2025. We are in the process of finding their family members, but in the meantime it is important that they feel at home in Bhalobasa. As for Ranu we are aware that she has a son who disowned her because of her unstable mind.

**Minoti Chatterjee** was rescued from the streets nearly 10 years ago by a family. She has been living with the family and working as a home help in few other houses. The family did all they could to get her various identification cards as a citizen of India, as well as registered her name under social security schemes.

While she was still able to care for herself and others, the family decided to move her to a safe place where she can stay permanently. This is how she has come to her new home in Charunibas. Minoti is more like a staff member and we are glad to welcome her home where she has settled very happily.



## REUNITING WITH FAMILY

Sushila Halder came to live in Bhalobasa on 18.08.2023. She was rescued and lived in a home run by AVIEW under the guidance of Dr. S. Brahma. Later her family was identified by AVIEW staff members and they kept in touch. Finally, when she was mentally fit, her nephew lovingly welcomed her home.

# SABAR COMMUNITY FOOD & MEDICAL PROGRAMME

### Rural Elderly Support Programme & its wider impacts

The support program for the distressed elderly in the rural areas of Hooghly district based at Kaikala village of Haripal block, has been going on for several years. In concrete terms, the program is meant to extend partial food support to the identified elderly persons by way of a monthly ration with occasional medical and clothing support.



While the material support is vital for distressed persons, the psychological impact of the program is of equal importance. The elderly beneficiaries now feel that they are not alone and unwanted, and there are people to feel for them and help them. It has a subtle impact on the behavior of the families, neighbors or community towards the beneficiaries. We have noticed that the beneficiaries are treated better. The support enhances their importance and dignity in the family and community.

The community's attitude towards this support program is visible when a beneficiary dies. The community is prompt to select another elderly person who is eligible to receive support and in most cases, there is neutrality and justification in that selection. There are now 31 beneficiaries. Nearly half of them are new beneficiaries coming under the program following the death of some old beneficiaries. To reiterate, it has turned out to be an important program for the elderly persons in the poorer communities who are old, sick, needy or deserted. It is so little in term of money but its impact is so BIG!

She loved to read and was far ahead of her fellow students, storing the knowledge in her mind and kept developing her understanding of what might lie ahead, the bigger world that we all expected she would be entering to improve the lives of herself, her family, her community and maybe even further. A brilliant mind coupled with honesty and a sense of humour.



On one of our last meetings, Afreen took over the whiteboard with a fellow student and was teaching her schoolfriends on behalf of a science teacher. We were all deeply impressed at her budding talents as a teacher, but when we asked what she wanted to study in the future, the answer came with a big smile "I am not sure yet, I am interested in science but also in many other subjects". So many doors seemed open for her.

We had big dreams for her, and so did her family. Little did any of us know, that she carried an undiagnosed heart disease within her body, which killed her with a lot of pain and agony less than two months later, at the tender age of 14, her beautiful life was over and she leaves behind a deeply grieving family, friends, teachers and many others who had the great fortune of meeting her.

In her last message to me, written the evening before her maths exam when she was busy studying, I wished her luck. She thanked me, and then wrote: "Good night mam". We will always miss you Afreen.




